

IMPACT ON PRICING OF THE LENGTH OF THE HARDSTANDING OCCUPANCY PERIOD							
1 - Overstay beyond the authorised occupancy period							
Any overstay on the hardstanding beyond the authorised period will lead to the charge for the entire period of occupancy of the hardstanding being doubled.							
2 - Early vacating of the space occupied							
The charge is due for the entire authorised occupancy period. By way of an exception, the Régie (haul-out service) will bill the actual hardstanding occupancy period, up to a maximum deduction of 3 days from the authorised period.							
3 - Extension of the occupancy period due to unforeseeable circumstances							
If occupancy of the hardstanding has to be prolonged due to unforeseeable circumstances (e.g. weather conditions), the customer will not be charged as long as they do not carry any work during this period.							
4 - Long occupancy periods and low season							
For occupancy periods of 3 weeks or more, authorised by the Régie (haul-out service) and actually completed, companies in the boat building/repair and nautical sectors will be exempted from the occupancy charge for Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays. They will also be granted a 20% discount during the period from 1 October to 31 January.							

The haul-out equipment tariff are those in effect at the beginning of the handling service
